Background: Moore undertook private practice of law in Gadsden, in 1984. He became a judge of the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit of Alabama in 1992, and served until his election as chief justice of the Alabama Supreme Court in 2000. In 2003, Chief Justice Moore was removed from his position for refusing to remove a monument of the 10 commandments from the Alabama Supreme Court Rotunda. In 2006 Moore entered the gubernatorial race against incumbent Bob Riley.
